ALL 2026 GRADUATING SENIORS RESIDING IN KINNEY COUNTY

The Kinney County Groundwater Conservation District will be offering **Scholarships** to the graduating seniors that reside in Kinney County attending Brackett ISD or home schooled. Up to \$12,500 in scholarship money has been allocated.

In order to qualify for a scholarship, students must submit to the District an essay of **750-1,000 words** on the following topic:

**How does a groundwater district manage and protect the groundwater resources for the landowners and all other water users within Kinney County?
Why do you believe you should be awarded this scholarship?**

The essay must be written in Microsoft Word Format and include references at the end of the essay. In addition to the essay, a cover letter with the Student's name, contact information, and acceptance letter to the college or technical school of their choice. Please no name on the essay.

The essay is **due no later than 12-NOON on April 24, 2026**, and must be submitted on a flash drive, in person, regular mail or email. If essay is to be mailed the envelope must be addressed as follows:
